CHAPEL OF CHIMES , bumped at the break, settled off the early pace and removed from the inside, took closer order three wide and in hand as a three way duel developed mid turn, angled out a bit and cruised up four wide to take command nearing the three sixteenths, drifted in while widening in mid stretch, was corrected with a few cracks of the left stick then pulled away under steady hand encouragement. GREAT ILLUSION , unhurried early, raced off the rail into the lane, brushed with CROOKIT near the three sixteenths, worked between rivals and gained the place. GROOVY DANCER , bumped at the start, was rated back from between rivals early, angled out around the turn and was put to pressure, circled four to five wide into the lane and kept on willingly. MISS NOSY moved three deep to join the pace fray into the turn, dueled under rating around the turn, poked a head in front entering the stretch, came under a drive past the quarter pole and gave way grudgingly. STAR EIGHTY cleared early and angled in, was joined near the five eighths, dueled inside a pair of rivals to the head of the lane then tired through the final furlong. CROOKIT saved ground under rating, came off the inside leaving the quarter pole, brushed with GREAT ILLUSION while steadying off the heels of a tiring rival soon after and failed to recover. STORMY MAMA bore out at the break and bumped with GROOVY DANCER, moved between rivals to challenge five furlongs out, vied to upper stretch then faltered.

GREATBULLSOFFIRE , in the three path between horses around the turn, closed determinedly inside DANCING WITH MAUDE and was up at the wire. DANCING WITH MAUDE , four wide on the turn, sprinted clear in mid stretch then gave way grudgingly. MARYLAND'S BEST , five deep around the turn, was well positioned entering the stretch, flattened out and drifted in near the sixteenth pole. SVENTASTIC raced in the three path between horses on the turn, gradually weakened and passed a tired rival late. SLICK MAN , squeezed back leaving the starting gate, was not a factor and raced five deep leaving the turn. IN ARREARS bore out leaving the starting gate, disputed the pace two wide around the turn and gave way. JERANDSON bumped APOLODORODEDAMASCO when bearing in at the break, raced in the two path on the turn and gave way. CHEROKEE SPIRIT , forced out by IN ARREARS leaving the starting gate, was outrun. APOLODORODEDAMASCO , bumped leaving the starting gate, raced along the rail on the turn and faltered. IGNOTUS raced along the rail, stopped on the turn, was eased and returned bleeding.

MY SON ERNIE advanced inside early to gain a stalking spot, had measure of the leaders saving ground past the three eighths, failed to kick on in upper stretch and dropped back. TAKEDOWN CHARLIE prompted the pace two wide, bid between rivals leaving the three eighths, vied into the lane then tired. SCIP OF VINDY was steadied soon after the break and failed to menace.

ADMIRALS WAR CHEST was nudged clear early then taken to rate, moved away from rivals when eager soon into the backstretch, remained under confident rating entering the far turn as rivals closed in, spurted back away leaving the five sixteenths, wandered outward when switching to his right lead a bit early, corrected soon into the stretch and held firm while only under steady hand encouragement. BULLHEADED BOY rated towards the inside, edged up near the half mile marker, angled out three wide leaving the three eighths, made a run into the lane, kept on gamely and was clearly second best. JUST JACK broke a tad slow, recovered and advanced while hung out four wide, stalked well off the inside leaving the five eighths, came under a ride three furlongs from home, gave hard pursuit into the lane, drifted in through the final furlong and gave way. I'M MR. BLUE settled off the pace while saving some ground, came out leaving the far turn, circled five wide into the lane but lacked a rally. FLASH MCCAUL, used between rivals early to reach a stalking position, continued between rivals into the far turn, failed to kick on when put to a ride and retreated in upper stretch. BIG BRANCH saved ground stalking the pace and faltered.

COACH MATTHEW , angled in early, raced along the rail on the turns, eased out to the two path leaving the far turn, gained command approaching the eighth pole, dug in and got the bob. GIN FUZZ , two wide the far turn, steadied behind the winner near the quarter pole, angled to the three path near the eighth pole and rallied outside the winner. KAMEHAMEHA , clear soon after the break, angled in, set the pace along the rail and weakened. BROTHER SLICK NICK circled the far turn, floated to the six path entering the stretch and passed tired horses. MY OWN LANE came out leaving the starting gate, raced three wide the first turn, chased the pace, was two wide the far turn, drifted out entering the stretch and weakened. PUBLISHANDITERATE , pinched back leaving the starting gate, raced in the three path on the far turn and came up empty in the stretch. HIBERNIA FIRE circled the far turn three wide, was carried to the five path entering the stretch and gave way. An objection by the rider of GIN FUZZ against the winner for alleged interference at the head of the stretch was not allowed. There was a stewards' inquiry concerning the run into the stretch but no action was taken.
