5. You do NOT get your money refunded for any reason.
6. You WILL automatically draw into the race.
7. The race must be ridden by a professional flat jockey and be a Thoroughbred flat race.
8. The race MUST run within 1 YEAR from which the event was held - Oct 21, 2022
9. You must give notice so the racing secretary can put it up as an extra on the overnight.
10. The purse will be comparable to similar conditions in the condition book.
11. You CANNOT sell your race to another horseman.
12. THE RACE MUST BE APPROVED BY THE RACING SECRETARY

Artist Peggy Kauffman received a BA in Fine Arts from Bennett College in Millbrook, New York, and furthered her education at the Maryland Institute College of Art in Baltimore. Skilled in the life history of horses from years of training, grooming and competition, Kauffman considers Paul Brown, preeminent American illustrator of equestrian subjects, the greatest influence on her work as an artist. One of her most prominent pieces, a bronze fox sold at Keeneland in 2021, went for a whopping \$44,000.

Kauffman is quoted as saying, "Representational Impressionism remains a focused quest as I aspire to balance a personal interpretation of my subjects while preserving the quality of realism a client expects from my work."
